7. What do you like most about the library?

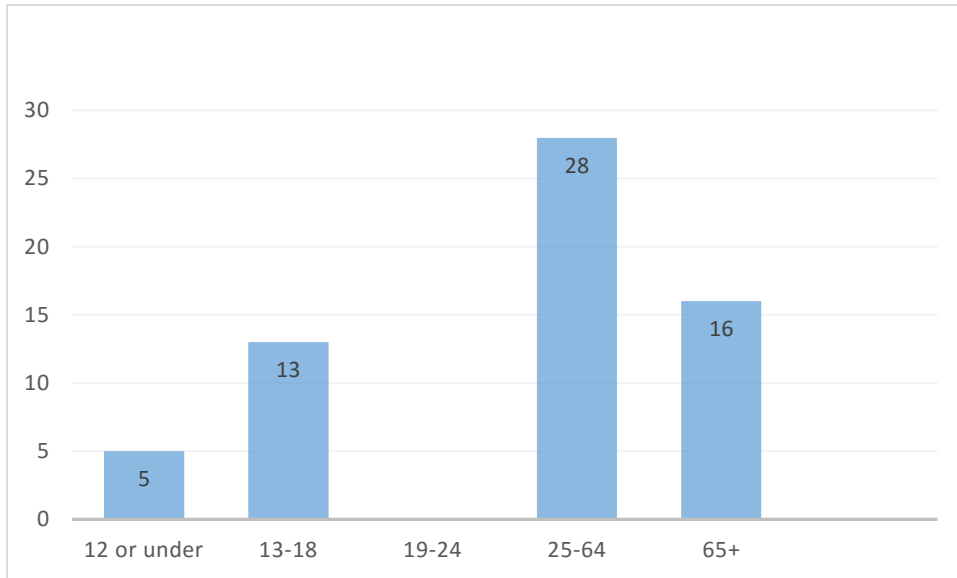
- coming after school
