The person in the position must be a positive and flexible individual who enjoys working with people of all ages and backgrounds, has outstanding communication and interpersonal skills, and will provide leadership in this role.

The candidate must have a minimum of an associate's degree in a related field and 3+ years of experience in an administrative/supervisory position. The candidate must have strong knowledge of library technology, digital resources, budgeting, and community engagement strategies.

The position is 32 hours per week. The salary starts at \$28,288 and is based on education and experience. Additional benefits include two weeks of annual vacation and up to 40 hours of annual sick time (as prescribed by NYS.
